Thank you to all those that have contributed towards the bench, as we have collected so much, we nearly have enough to replace the third seat. I will save the money in a special fund and apply for the faculties in the New Year.

Sorry there will be a short delay in replacing the benches as we now have the faculties to remove the 4 trees that are damaging the structure of the church. It seems more sensible to get the trees down before replacing the benches in case they get damaged.
