### Remembrance Service Sunday 31st October

In two weeks' time, we are holding our annual Remembrance and Thanksgiving Service to which we invite every member of our congregation, families and friends to gather together to remember with love all who have died and whose funerals have taken place during the past 15+ months. In addition to members of our own family or friends, it is a time when we should also remember all the people in our Front-Line Services (NHS, Ambulance, Fire, Transport, etc.,) who died during the Covid-19 Pandemic.

It will be an informal service, with familiar hymns and music, readings and prayers, and an appropriate address for the occasion. There will also be an opportunity to light a Candle of Remembrance, and to hang a memory card on our tree. These cards will be available in church prior to the start of the service.
