We need this information in order to communicate about the Course in Christian Studies. Your personal data will be stored on the course administrator's database and will be held securely in line with the CDBF's Data Protection Policy.

Your data will be shared with the relevant course tutor in order for them to communicate with you for the duration of the course. Otherwise your data will not be shared with third parties without your consent. If you complete the course your personal data will be retained for a period of 5 years in case you wish to take part in further vocational training offered through the CDBF. During this time you will have the option to act as a parish contact which would involve receiving material about future CCSs in order to share and promote the course with other Church members. You are given the option to opt in to do this at the end of your first year with CCS. If you agreed to do this, you can withdraw from this at any time by contacting the course administrator.
