This year's Annual Lent Lecture is going to be at Billericay Methodist Church, Western Road. The title of the lecture is: 'The Bible and People of Other Faiths: A Personal and Theological Journey' and will be given by Dr Elizabeth Harris, honorary Senior Research Fellow within the Edward Cadbury Centre for the Public Understanding of Religion, University of Birmingham, UK.

The Annual Lent Lecture aims to kickstart the journey of Lent by bringing people together from across Billericay, Wickford, Basildon and beyond to share an experience of learning together. It aims to make cutting-edge scholarship accessible to lay people by bridging academia and church/faith and learning to inspire fresh thinking and enable the people of God to encounter afresh the transforming power of the cross of the living and active Jesus.
